




#### Policy and Public Affairs Priority Map – 2021 YTD



# Leasing Policy development process Conference



#### Become aware of an issue

For example, a consultation is announced, or members raise concerns

#### Discuss issue internally

- Decide if new mandate is required
- Log process and get internal signoff on mandate requirement

#### No new mandate required if:

- We already have a sufficient mandate
- It is a small or niche issue, only of interest to a sub-section of members

#### Process without a new mandate

- Develop a response with the support of working groups, expert members and stakeholders (eg.FLA; Leaseurope; Logistics UK; RHA)
- Sign-off only required at CEO level
- Communicate via email bulletins and website

#### If new mandate required

- Solicit member feedback via email bulletin
- Discuss issue with working groups, committees, expert/interested members or industry stakeholders
- Share draft with appropriate committee members
- Amend draft and receive internal sign-off
- Share final draft with appropriate committees and Committee of Management
- Submit response/output
- Publish on website and highlight in email bulletin
