

The BVRLA fleet remained broadly unchanged in 2021

Despite the impact of the Covid pandemic, falling demand for BCH was offset by continuing growth in personal leasing.

Total fleet size is 1,8million (just 0.4% lower than same period last year)


The Leasing Broker channel grew by 8% to just under 400,000 cars and vans, representing 22% of BVRLA's total fleet.

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Total Fleet 1,803,810: 74% cars/26% vans





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


The future looks good for EVs

However, latest data from SMMT indicates that continuing to meet demand will be challenging due to semi-conductor shortages.


