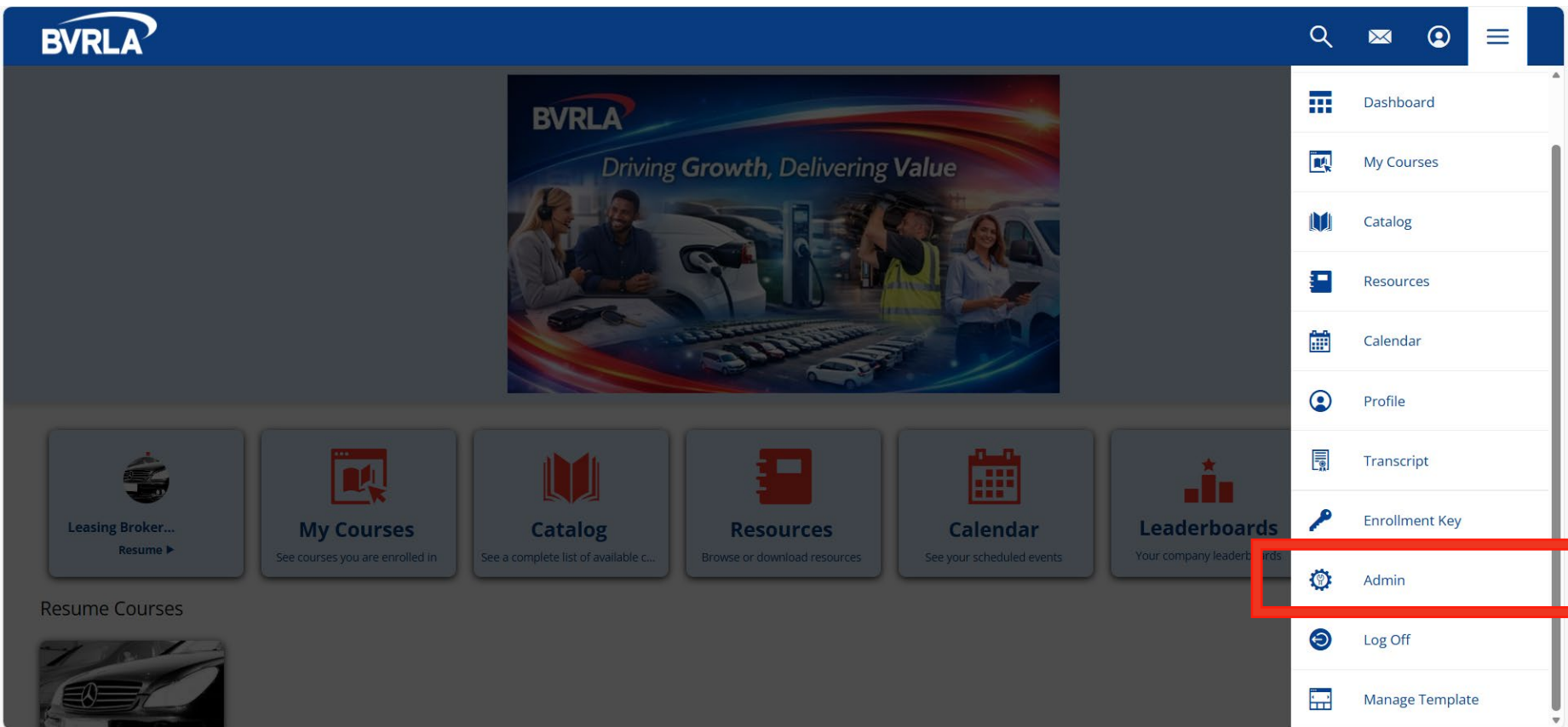

Accessing the admin dashboard

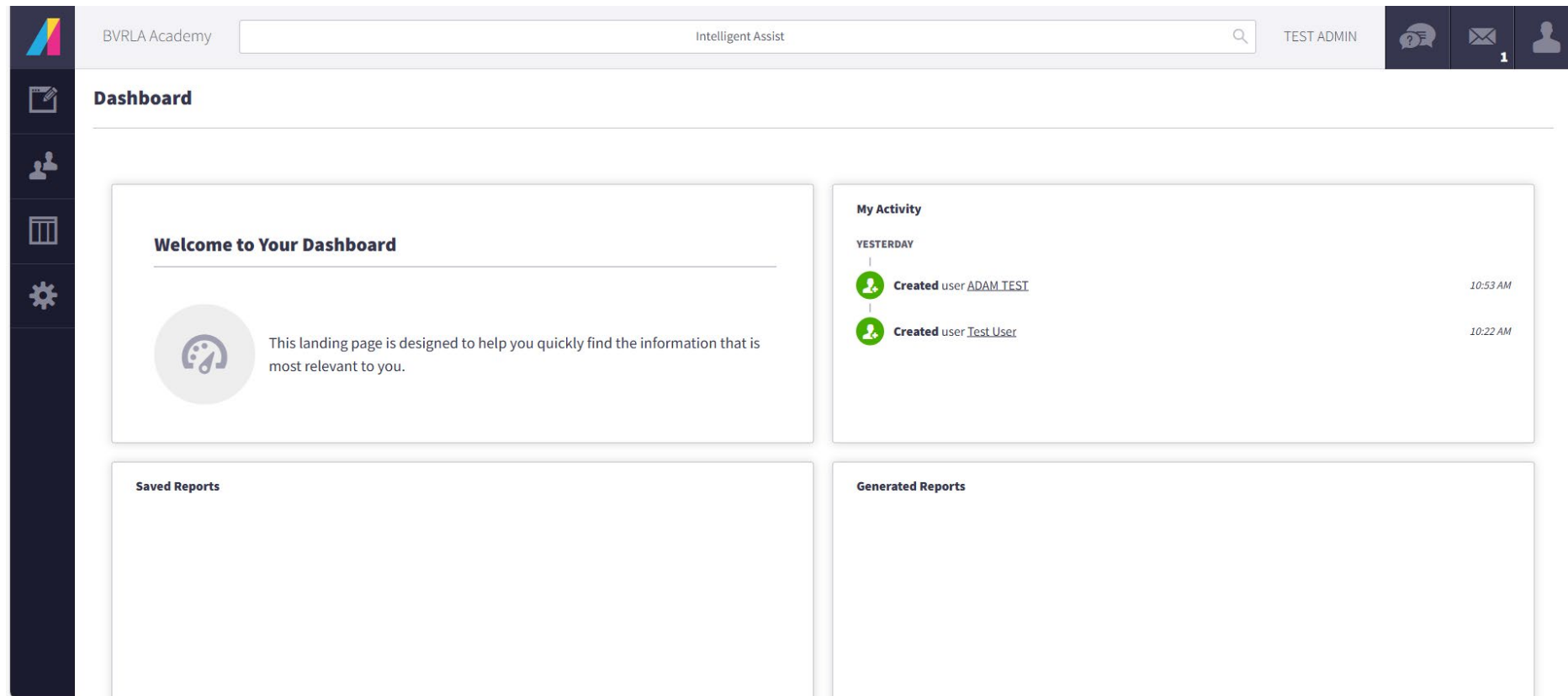
- Once you have logged in to the platform, click on the main menu button in the top right corner of the screen.

Then click on 'Admin' in the list.

The admin dashboard will look similar to this:

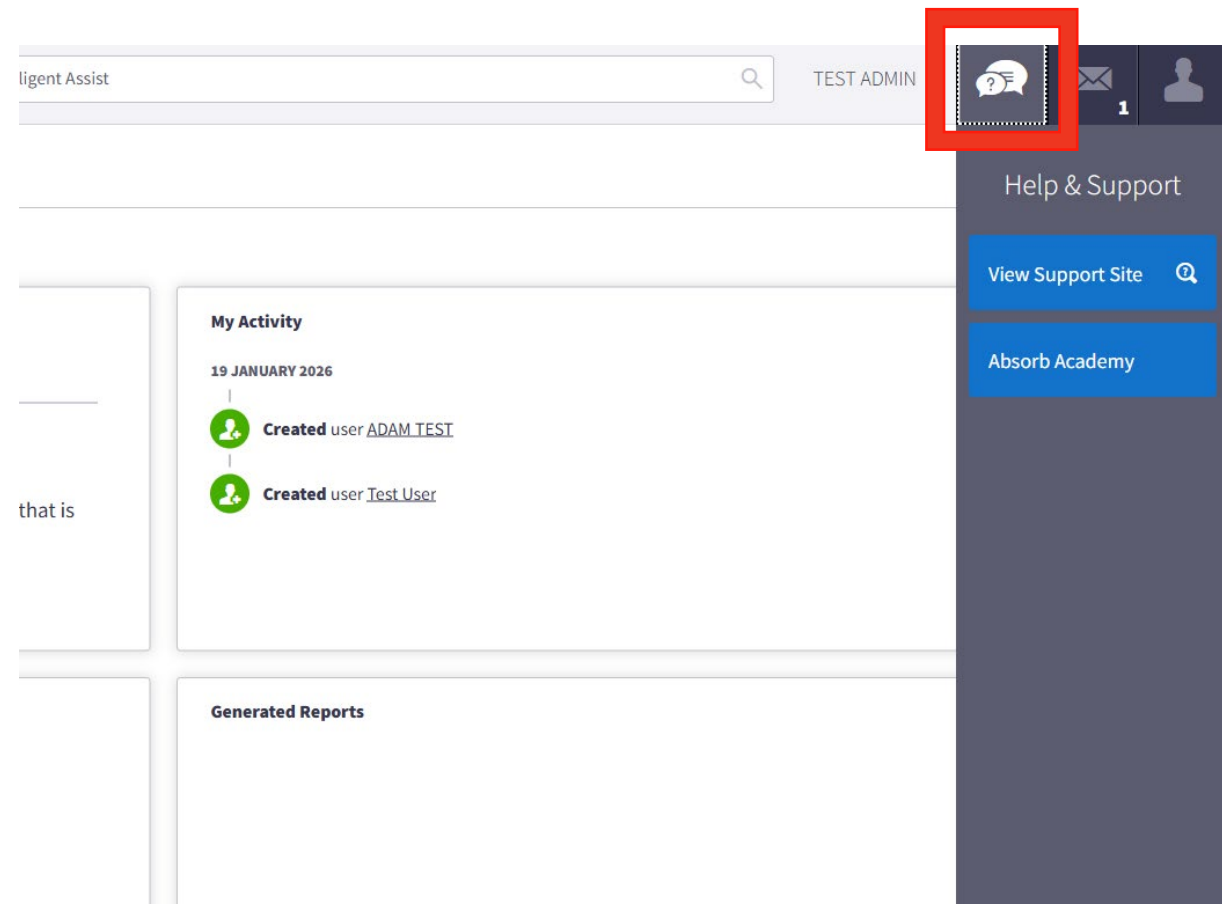


Our training module explains how to personalise the dashboard with useful widgets and trackers that show user progress.

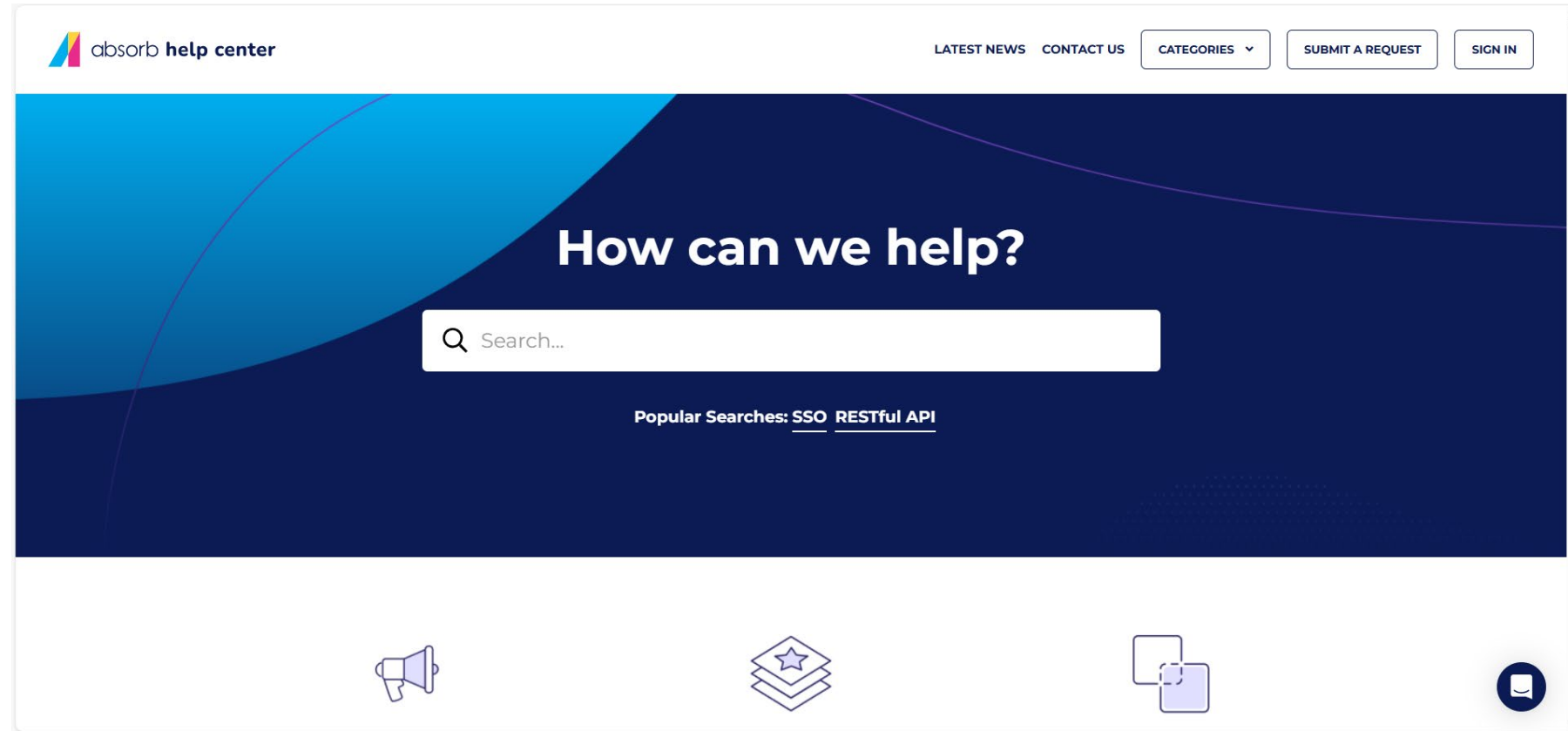
If you need any help with locating a specific section or item in the admin dashboard, there are a number of options you can use to find the answer.

At the top of the screen is the Help button



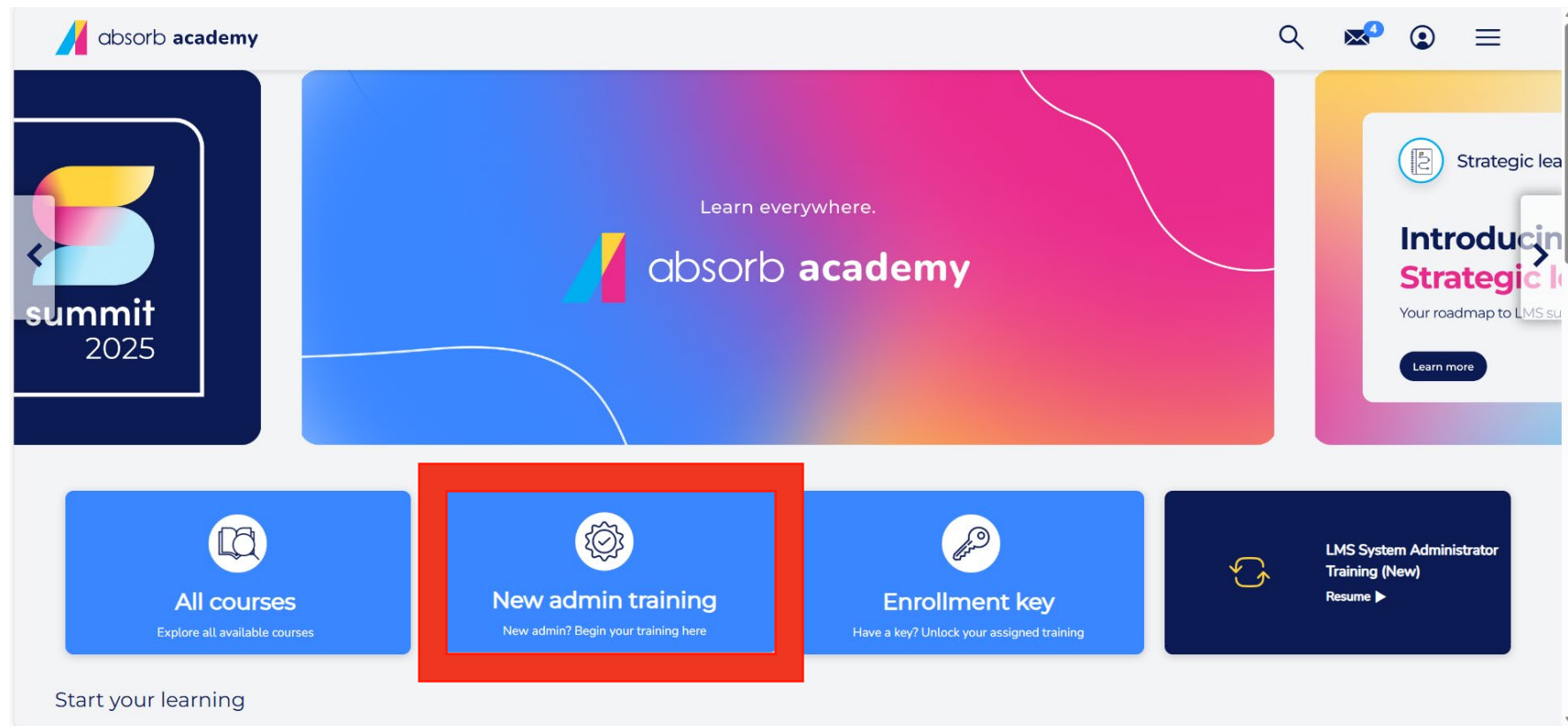

Click on 'View Support Site' and you will be taken to the Absorb help page where you can view help guides and FAQs





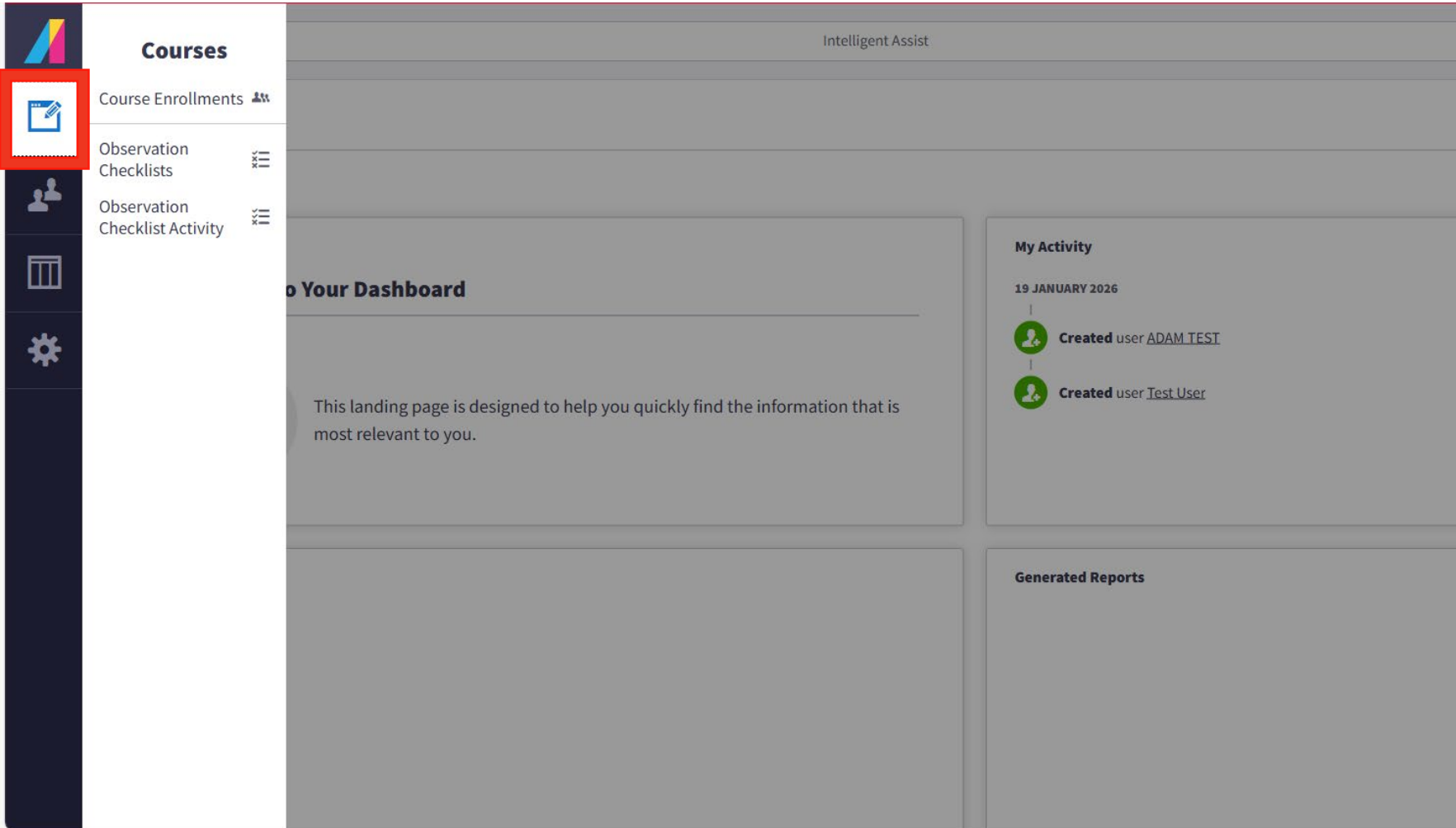

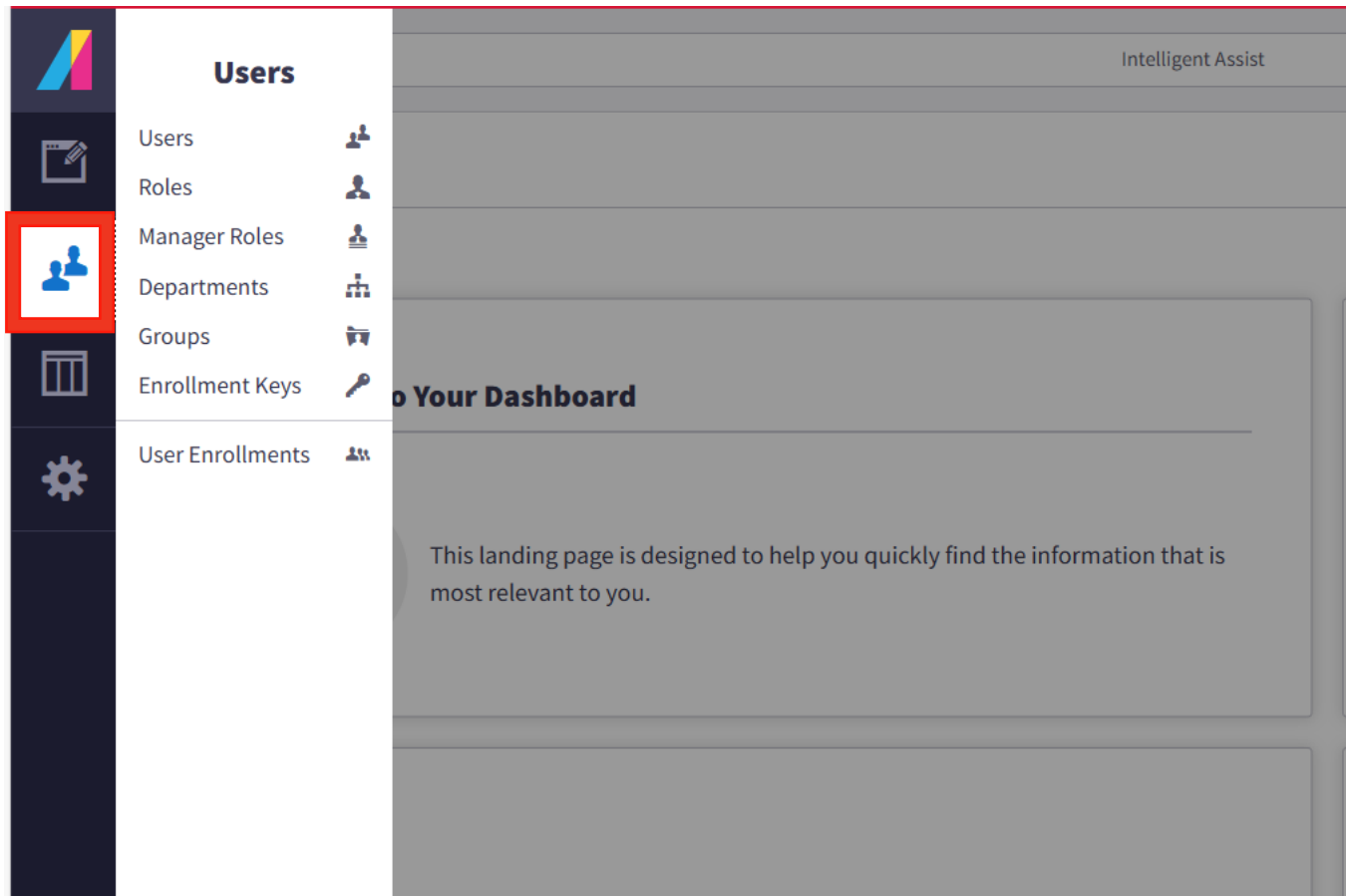
Admin menu

On the left side of the screen, you will find four buttons. The first is the Courses menu, you can view course enrolments and observation tasks here.



Admin menu

The next button is the Users menu. Here you can add users, assign roles, manage departments and view enrolment keys. Enrolment keys are a unique code for learners to log in with. Their training then gets automatically assigned. We'll cover this in more detail later.



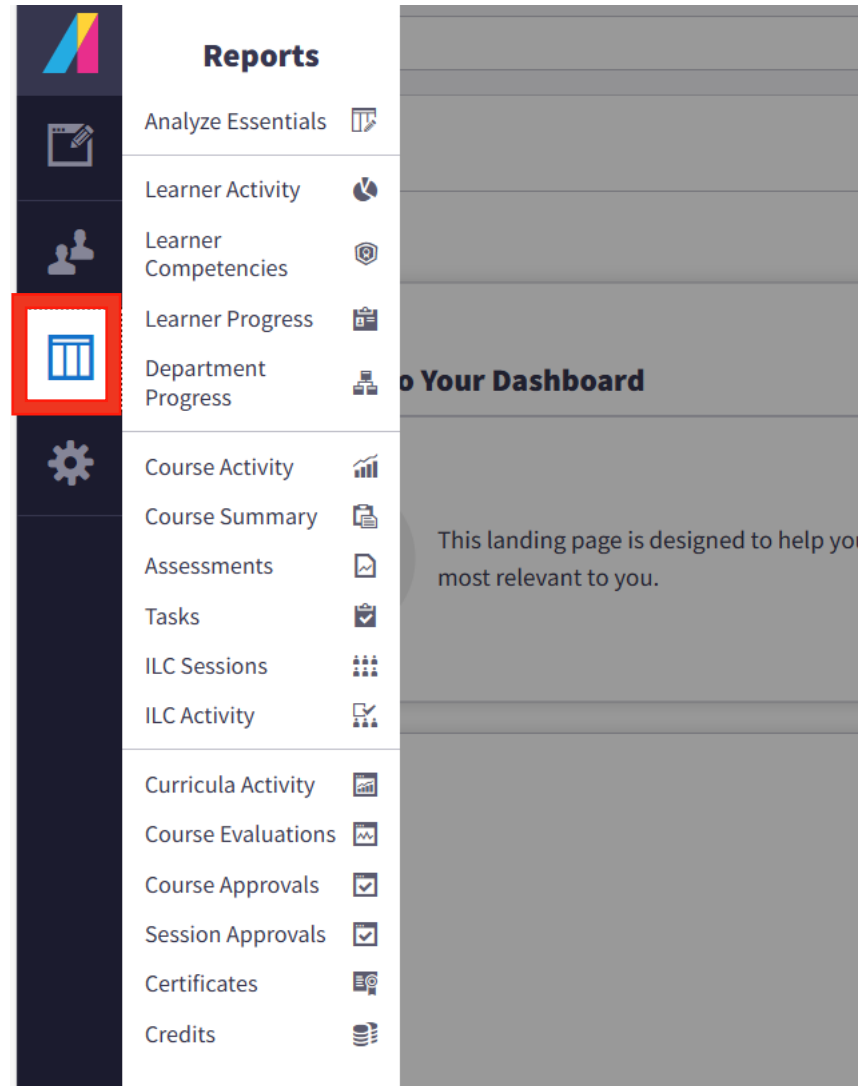
Admin menu

The next button is the Reports menu. This is where all your reports are stored. You will see a number of pre-built reports in the list. You can also create your own reports.

All reports can be exported as a CSV file if needed.

Admins can also view certificates here.

If you need any support with setting up custom reports, do let us know and we can get in touch over MS Teams.

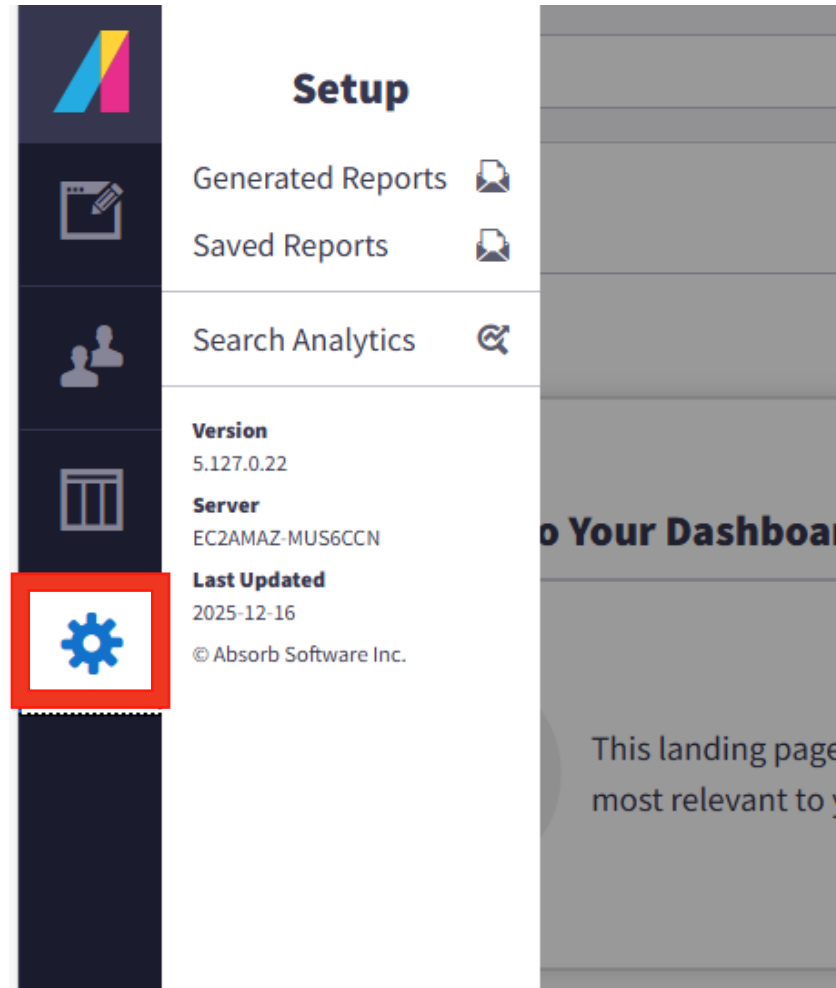


Admin menu

The last button is the Setup menu.

Here you can view your saved reports and any reports you have generated recently.

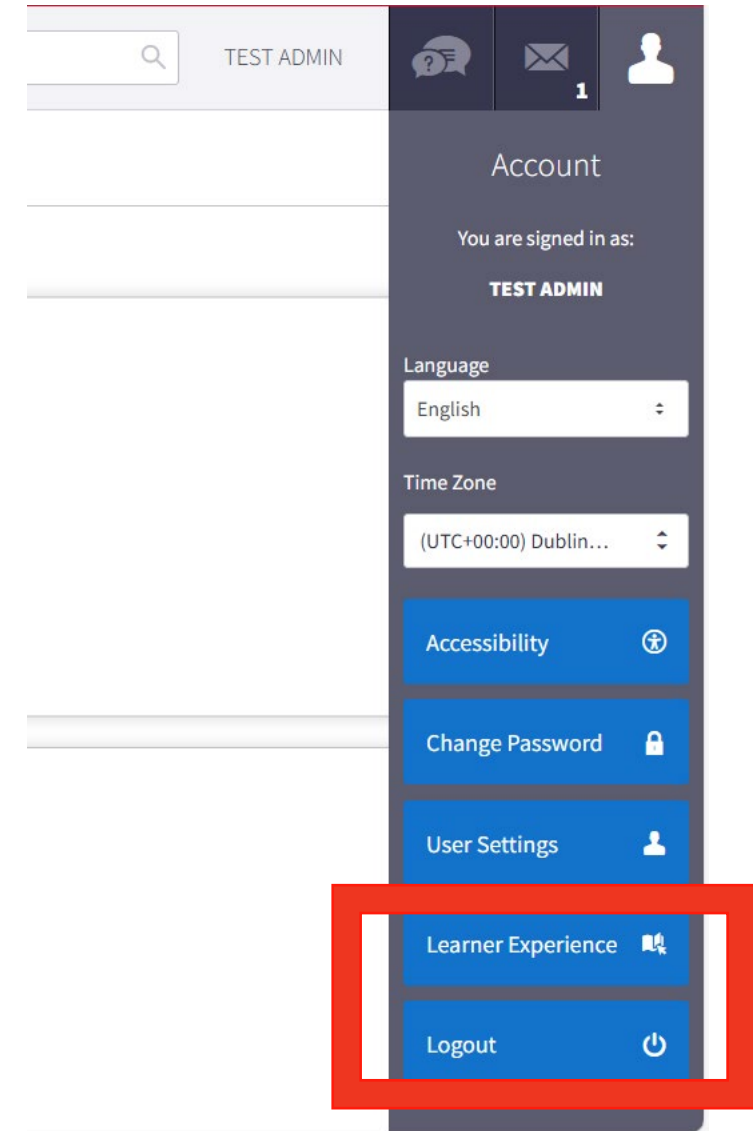
You can also view Search Analytics to understand the common knowledge gaps users are searching for.



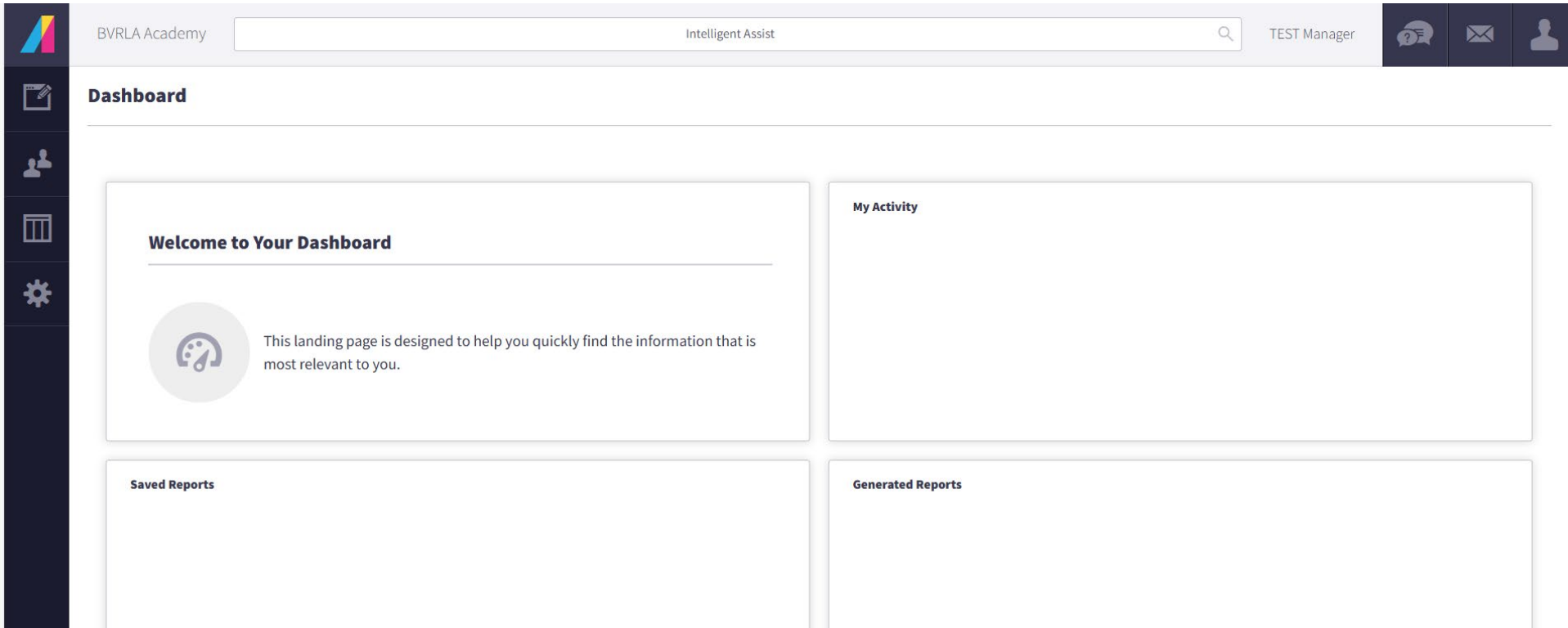
Return to learner dashboard

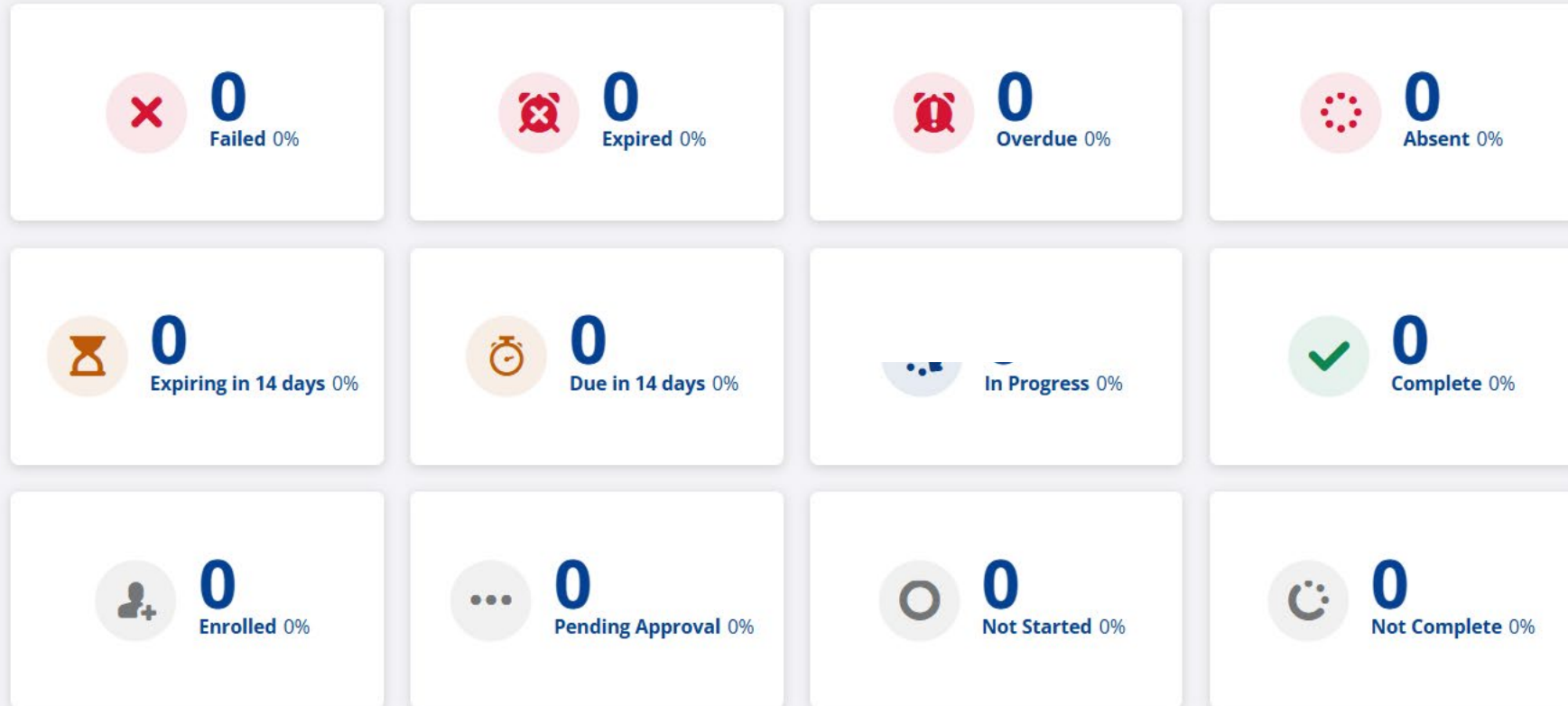
